FINANCIAL DATA SHEET for NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS 2016-17

TUITION: The tuition for the 2016-17 academic year is **\$33,950.00*** per student. Tuition for international students is to be paid by the semester or by the year. This tuition fee includes general classroom subjects, dormitory housing, meals, text books, weekend field trips, coordination of homestay on long holidays, a **NON-REFUNDABLE** activity fee of \$225.00, and a trip to Disney World during the Mardi Gras break (February 26 – March 4, 2017).

TUITION PAYMENTS: The tuition payment plans offered by Saint Stanislaus are:

*Tuition includes \$50 standardized test preparation fee that will provide students with a series of test prep resources, an official ACT test for juniors and seniors, practice ACT tests and feedback for all other grade levels, and additional PSAT prep.

LATE ENROLLMENT: If your son enrolls any time during the first quarter, the full yearly tuition is due. If your son enrolls in the second quarter, tuition for the remainder of the year is \$25,050.00. If he enrolls during the third quarter, tuition for the remainder of the year is \$17,500.00.

APPLICATION/DEPOSIT FEE: After your son has been accepted, the \$800 Deposit is due. The Deposit reserves a place for your son at Saint Stanislaus. After we receive this fee, we will mail the I-20 and acceptance letter to you which will enable your son to apply for an F-1 Student Visa with the United States embassy in your son's home country. This fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE** unless your son is denied a student visa from the U.S. embassy. If your son does not receive a student visa, the school will retain \$100 as an application fee and refund the \$700 remainder.

SPECIAL FEES: Other fees that may be due are:

1. **ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (ESL)** (\$750.00 due on August 5, 2016 & on December 5, 2016) \$1,500.00
2. **ACADEMIC ASSISTANCE FEE** (\$650.00 due on August 5, 2016 & on December 5, 2016) \$1,300.00
3. **MEDICAL FEE** (required – refunded at end of year, if not used) \$250.00
4. **SCHOOL UNIFORMS** (If student does not purchase before arriving- Due with tuition) \$300.00
5. **STUDENT ACCOUNT** (Emergencies & Airport Transportation. Remainder refunded at end of year, if not used) \$400.00
6. **SENIOR GRADUATION AND RETREAT FEE** (For incoming seniors only. Due February 5, 2017) \$225.00
7. **8th GRADE PROMOTION FEE** (For incoming 8th graders only – due February 5, 2017) \$65.00
8. **LATE TUITION FEE** assessed on the 10th of each month \$25.00
9. **EARLY WITHDRAWAL FEE:** If a student leaves before December 5, 2016 the remainder of the 1st semester tuition is forfeited. If a student leaves after December 5, 2016, a 30-day penalty applies (30 @ \$188.61= \$5,658.30). If a student enters during the 2nd semester and leaves before the end of that semester, he forfeits the remainder of that semester's tuition.

ALLOWANCE: The suggested weekly allowance is between \$10 and \$25 a week. The balance of the allowance account, less all outstanding charges, is refunded at the end of the year. In the event of absence, withdrawal, or dismissal, the remaining balance will be **paid by check** and mailed to the family ten working days after the separation. No exceptions are given to this policy. Parents must pay for allowances by the semester or full year. In order to calculate the allowance charges, please use the formula below.

PAYMENT METHOD: Saint Stanislaus accepts cash, wire transfer, automatic draft, VISA, MasterCard, and Discover Card to pay tuition and fees for the 2016-17 school year. There is a 2.44% service charge to process credit card payments.

RESIDENT STUDENT TUITION COLLECTION POLICY (2016-17)

DUE DATES FOR PAYMENTS: Yearly Payment: due August 5, 2016
Semester Payments: due August 5, 2016 and December 5, 2016

BEGINNING OF SCHOOL: Before a student is allowed to begin school in August, the full yearly tuition or the 1st semester tuition must be paid in full by August 5, 2016.

STATEMENTS: Monthly statements are **emailed** ten (10) days prior to the payment due dates (approximately the 26th of each month). Resident student charges are due on the 5th of each month. Statements for resident students will include all Campus Store charges, cash advances, etc. Please ensure you have a valid email address on file.

PAST DUE PAYMENTS: Five (5) days after the payment on a student's account is due and not paid in full (i.e., on the 10th of the month), the account becomes "Past Due" and a late tuition fee of \$25 will be assessed each month that the account is in arrears.

QUARTER AND SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS: Parents of the students whose tuition accounts are in arrears will be notified prior to the start of examinations that their son may not sit for exams until payment is made in full. Delinquent payments that are made immediately prior to examinations must be by cash, cashier's check, or money order.

COMMUNICATION BY PARENTS: It is the responsibility of the parents to contact the President of Saint Stanislaus should extenuating circumstances necessitate a temporary adjustment in payments. Such communication must take place prior to, rather than after, written communication from the school.

METHODS OF PAYMENT: SSC will accept cash, check, automatic draft, VISA, MasterCard, and Discover Card to pay tuition and fees for the 2016-17 school year. There is a 2.44% service charge to process credit card payments.

CHECKS: Checks returned to the school by the bank as "NSF Checks" will be deposited a second time. A \$25 "NSF Assessment" is charged to the parents' account. Should an "NSF Check" not clear the second time, parents will be informed that payment must be made by cash, cashier's check, or money order.

RECURRING PROBLEMS: If a pattern of "NSF Checks" develops, parents will be notified that all future payments must be made by cash, cashier's check, credit card, or money order.

STUDENT DEPARTURES: Should a resident student withdraw or be dismissed for any reason, Early Withdrawal Fees will be assessed as follows:

1st Semester

If an international resident student leaves before December 5, 2016, the remainder of the first semester tuition is forfeited. If an international resident student leaves after December 5, 2016, he will be **assessed a \$5,658.30 penalty fee.**

2nd Semester

If an international resident student enters during the 2nd Semester and leaves before the end of that semester, he **forfeits the remainder of that semester's tuition.**

COLLECTION COST: Parent(s)/Guardian(s) are liable for any collection or legal fees incurred by the school to collect delinquent accounts.
