Honors and Advanced Placement Classes

Saint Stanislaus is proud to challenge academically qualified students by offering Honors and Advanced Placement courses. To encourage our students to work toward their potential, and to provide opportunities for a broader education, we provide an Honors program for students in their Sophomore, Junior and Senior years. While Honors classes are offered beginning in the eighth grade, a qualified student officially enrolls in the Honors Program at the beginning of Tenth grade. Upon successful completion of the Honors curriculum, he will receive an Honors Diploma at graduation.

Advanced Placement classes are also available to students beginning in the Sophomore year. Participation in both AP and Honors classes is contingent upon recommendation from faculty and administration and both require dedication and diligence from the student. College credit is available to students who perform well on the AP final assessment.
