Student ID Card



Each Student Issued an ID Card

Soon after his arrival at Saint Stanislaus, each student is issued an ID card that is valid for the school year. This ID card also serves (for day students) as a student's debit card for purchases of lunch (and breakfast for day students who choose to eat breakfast at school) in the College Café.

Day Students

Day students deposit money in their lunch account in advance and are encouraged to put a deposit on their account at orientation in August. Throughout the year, parents of day students can add money to a student's lunch account through the finance office by cash, check, or credit card. Parents may also choose to set up lunch payments through FACTS. Students may not incur a negative balance on their lunch account; we cannot charge meals.

Resident Students

Resident students present their current student ID card for lunch in the student dining room during the school week.

Replacement Cards

A \$10 fee is charged to replace a student ID. Replacement IDs are purchased in the principal's office. No student may allow another student to borrow or otherwise use his ID for any reason whatsoever.
