2023-2024 Tuition, Fees and Financial Policies for U.S. Resident Students

TUITION: The tuition, room and board for the 2023-24 school year is \$33,450.00 per student.

TWO TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS:

RE-REGISTRATION FEE: A NON-REFUNDABLE Registration Fee of \$300.00 is due by March 3, 2023. The Registration Fee is \$450.00 if paid after March 3, 2023.

METHOD OF PAYMENT FOR TUITION AND FEES: All parents are required to enroll in the FACTS Tuition Management Program.

SPECIAL FEES: Other fees that may be due are:

- 1. ACADEMIC ASSISTANCE FEE**
(billed based on tuition payment option chosen) \$2,000.00
- 2. SENIOR FEE** (billed in September) \$400.00
- 3. 8th GRADE PROMOTION FEE** (billed in September) \$65.00

ALLOWANCES: If you would like your son to have cash during the week, we will provide him with a weekly allowance. The suggested weekly allowance is between \$10 and \$25 a week. Allowance is billed per semester. Unused allowance will be refunded at the end of the year.

DELINQUENT TUITION: FACTS Tuition Management Program will notify SSC that an account is in arrears. SSC reserves the right to suspend a student from school until tuition is up to date. Students with indebtedness to the school are not eligible for exams or graduation.

COMMUNICATION BY PARENTS: It is the responsibility of the parents to contact the President of Saint Stanislaus should extenuating circumstances necessitate a temporary adjustment in payments. Such communication must take place prior to, rather than after, an account is delinquent.

EARLY DEPARTURE: Should a resident student withdraw or be dismissed for any reason, a 30 school day penalty of \$5,575.00 will be assessed.

CHECKS: There is a \$50.00 NSF fee for any payments made directly to SSC by check (such as for lunch, field trips, bookstore and the like) that are returned to the school by the bank as "NSF."
